

New Americans in **Kansas**



6.9% of Kansans are foreign born

13.0% are Latino or Asian



33.9% of immigrants in the state are naturalized U.S. citizens

3.7% of registered voters are New Americans



87.9% of children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens

83.4% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient



73.8% of naturalized citizens have a high school diploma or higher

9,277 foreign students contribute **\$204 million** to the state's economy



Make up **8.6%** of the workforce.

3.3% of the workforce is unauthorized.



DID YOU KNOW?

Kansas would lose **\$1.8 billion** in economic activity and about **11,879 jobs** if all unauthorized immigrants were removed.

Latino-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$1.3 billion** and employed **7,935** people

Asian-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$1.4 billion** and employed **12,676** people

The purchasing power of Latinos is **\$6.7 billion**. Asian buying power totaled **\$3.1 billion**.
