

NEW AMERICANS IN MINNESOTA

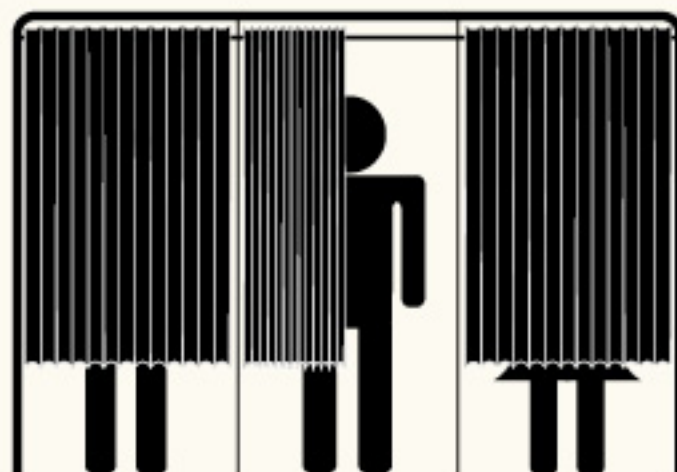


7.1% of Minnesotans are foreign born.

8.7% of Minnesotans are Latino or Asian.

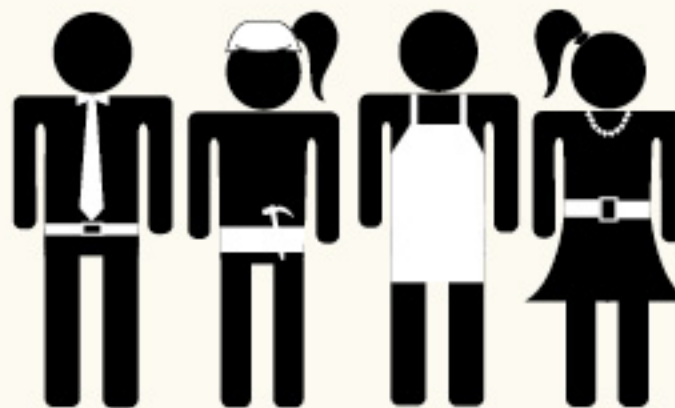
44.7% of immigrants in the state are eligible to vote.

4.3% of registered voters are New Americans.



Minnesota has 11,550 foreign students who contribute **\$276.3 million** to the state economy.

35.3% of foreign-born adults have a bachelor's degree or higher.

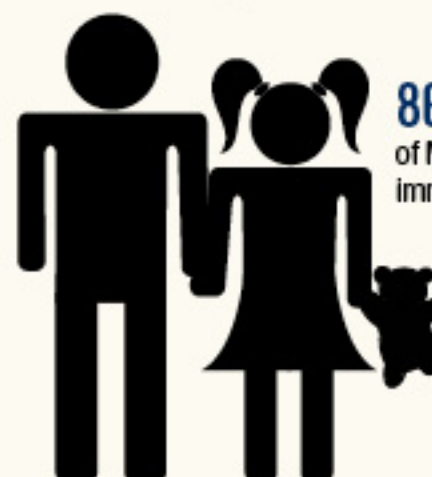


Immigrants are **8.3%** of the state's workforce. **2.1%** of the workforce is unauthorized.

Asian-owned businesses in Minnesota have sales and receipts of **\$2.4 billion**.

Latino-owned businesses in Minnesota have sales and receipts of **\$1.6 billion**.

The purchasing power of Minnesota's Latino population and Asian population, respectively, is **\$5.1 billion** and **\$5.9 billion**.



86.3% of Minnesota's children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens.

79.1% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient.

DID YOU KNOW? Minnesota would lose **\$4.4 billion** in economic activity if all unauthorized immigrants were removed.
