

NEW AMERICANS IN WYOMING

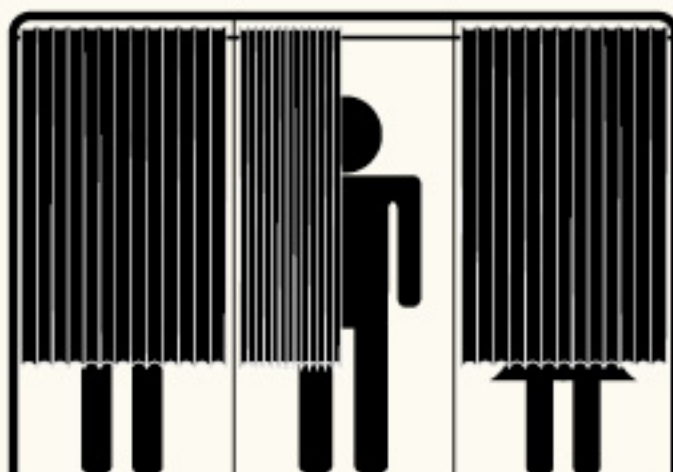


2.8% of Wyomans are foreign born.

9.7% of Wyomans are Latino or Asian.

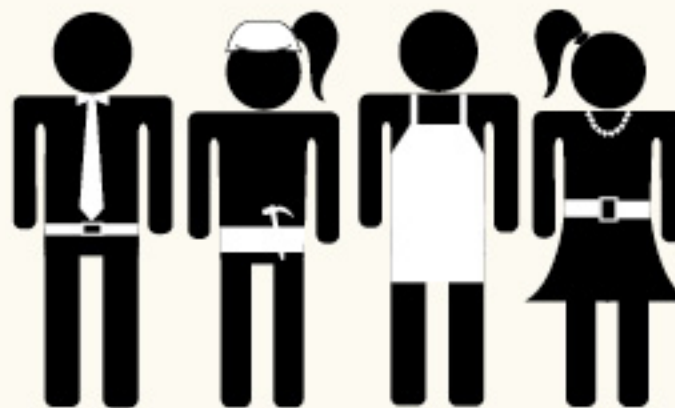
40.7% of immigrants in the state are eligible to vote.

1.8% of registered voters are New Americans.



Wyoming has 1,010 foreign students who contribute **\$18.8 million** to the state economy.

20.2% of foreign-born adults have a bachelor's degree or higher.

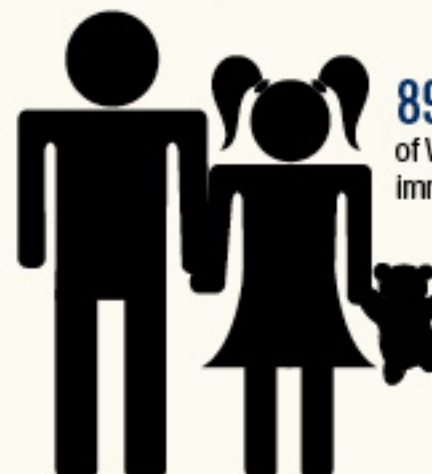


Asian-owned businesses in Wyoming have sales and receipts of **\$127.2 million**.

Latino-owned businesses in Wyoming have sales and receipts of **\$192.3 million**.

Immigrants are **2.8%** of the state's workforce. **1.5%** of the workforce is unauthorized.

The purchasing power of Wyoming's Latino population and Asian population, respectively, is **\$1.3 billion** and **\$238 million**.



89.7% of Wyoming's children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens.

88.1% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient.

DID YOU KNOW? Wyoming would lose **\$194 million** in economic activity if unauthorized immigrants were removed.
