

New Americans in Wyoming



3.2% of Wyomans are foreign born

10% are Latino or Asian



32.5% of immigrants in the state are naturalized U.S. citizens

1.8% of registered voters are New Americans



89.7% of children with immigrant parents are U.S. citizens

88.1% of children with immigrant parents are English proficient



82.3% of naturalized citizens have a high school diploma or higher

1,072 foreign students contribute **\$20.3 million** to the state's economy



Make up **3.6%** of the workforce.

<1.5% of the workforce is unauthorized.



DID YOU KNOW?

Wyoming would lose **\$194.3 million** in economic activity and about **1,260 jobs** if all unauthorized immigrants were removed.

Latino-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$192.3 million** and employed **2,227** people

Asian-owned businesses had sales and receipts of **\$127.2 million** and employed **1,623** people

The purchasing power of Latinos is **\$1.6 billion**. Asian buying power totaled **\$365 million**.
